VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITES

Volunteers are needed in the areas listed below. Please check the activity/activities below that interest you.

Citizens on Patrol (COP) - Organizes and participates in periodic patrols of the community to prevent crime. Works with local police departments on crime issues, coordinates with neighboring community associations, and seeks funding to support anti-crime initiatives in Franklinton.

Community Conservation – Keeps an eye on properties and vehicles throughout the community to make sure that community standards are maintained and that zoning regulations are enforced. Works closely with city and county zoning enforcement officials.

Community planning calendar-Creates, maintains and updates a calendar of events and activities that occur in or impact the Franklinton community.

Environmental issues-Organizes and promotes community cleanups. Promotes trails and other outdoor activities for the community. Researches environmental issues that impact the community.

Gatehouse-Maintains cleanliness of the Gatehouse on the corner of Kernan Hospital campus (at Windsor Mill Road and Forrest Park Avenue), restocks snacks, and works with Baltimore City Police to insure comfort and usefulness of the Gatehouse to crime prevention activities.

Hospitality –Handles arrangements for meetings and special events in the community. Maintains a “welcome wagon” to introduce new neighbors to life in Franklinton and Baltimore and the value of the community association.

Fundraising & Grant writing- Organizes special events to raise money for FCA and identifies agencies and/organizations that fund grants that are appropriate for FCA.

Membership -Coordinates and maintains the monthly records of FCA members. Report monthly activity to FCA board members.

Newsletter- Creates, organizes and prints a newsletter for distribution to Community members.

Newsletter distribution- Coordinates the timely distribution of the newsletter.

Roads – Identifies road problems such as potholes, signal issues, etc. Maintains a relationship with city and county roads departments to insure prompt response to community complaints.

Redline- Attends meetings relating to the Redline. Apprises the FCA Board and the community of the impact of the Redline on the Franklinton community.

School Liaison- Maintains contact with schools located in Franklinton.

Website- Serves as the liaison between FCA president/board and the Webmaster. Insures that the information on FCA’s website is up to date and accurate. www.franklintown.org
